

Application for approval to Burn a Rural Road Reserve or Other Council Controlled Reserve

The following application MUST be completed prior to any burn-off activity to be undertaken on Council controlled property, in the North Burnett Regional Shire. Council controlled property includes all local rural road reserves and any other reserve that is the responsibility of the North Burnett Regional Council. Without consent from the North Burnett Regional Council, burning is prohibited and is an offence. Once approval has been obtained from the North Burnett Regional Council, a 'permit to burn' MUST be obtained from the Local Fire Warden.
