Proposal summary 1

- The applicant seeks approval for a minor change to DA294/10: Reconfiguration of lot (1) Minor Change for subdivision of 1 lot into 13 lots on land described as Lot 1 on SP252634, approved by Council on 9 February 2012.
- The change application proposes to-(2)
 - Remove stage 2: (a)
 - Present lots individually for sealing; and (b)
 - (c) Remove the additional intersection requirements that DTMR conditioned due to existing infrastructure and traffic safety concerns.
- (3)The proposal does meet the definition of Minor change under Schedule 2 of the Planning Act 2016 as it does not result in a substantially different application as the number of lots and size or orientation of the lots are not changing.
- The proposal required referral to SARA and DTMR where a concurrence agency. They (4) approved the proposed changes.
- (5)The proposal did not require public notification.
- The proposal would not introduce any additional impacts on the natural and built (6)environment and the proposal complies with relevant assessment benchmarks.
- (7) The Council must assess and decide the application under section 82 of the Planning Act 2016. The assessment is to be against the assessment benchmarks (Centre zone code ant the Infrastructure and operational work code) in the context of development approval 183/19.

Recommendations 2

- That the Council or its delegate decide the application under section 82 Planning Act 2016 (1)by approving it subject to conditions.
- That the Council notify the applicant of its decision. (2)
