The North Burnett Regional Council has determined the following additional information is needed to assess the application—

1. Stormwater (Quality)—The Contour Consulting Engineering Report, Section 4.3 Stormwater Quality Management, states that stormwater management measures are not required as the proposed road circulation and building area occupy a space of approximately 2250m² and that load reduction targets are only application per the State Planning Policy (SPP) for an MCU if the premises exceeds 2500m². Lots 11 and 21 have a combined premises area of 4047m², and the 2250m² impervious area is more than 25% of the developable area. In this circumstance, SPP Table B: Post Construction Phase (1)(b) requires that the stormwater quality design objectives are required to be met.

- a. Please provide further information demonstrating how the SPP Post construction phase stormwater requirements will be achieved.
- Lawful discharge—Section 4.2 of the Contour Consulting Engineering Report states that the
 nominated lawful point of discharge for the development is the John St road reserve and adjoining
 open channel drain. Sub-surface detention is proposed with overflow waters piped to the lawful
 point of discharge.
 - a. Please provide further details about the outlet to John St including a cross section of the proposed stormwater detention arrangement demonstrating that an outlet to the open drain in John St can be achieved.
- 3. Sewer—The development proposes new permanent built form proximate to existing reticulated sewerage mains. The proximity of proposed built form is likely to impact Council's future interests to facilitate sewerage maintenance or replacement.
 - a. To facilitate reasonable future sewer maintenance/replacement access, relocate proposed building(s) and surrounds so that the existing sewer is a minimum of 1.5 metres from any building and raised surrounds.
- 4. Pavement Impacts—Frederick St is an existing local access street and the development proposes all trucks and service vehicle ingress movements, up to a B-Double heavy vehicle, to occur from this frontage. Council has concerns about the suitability of the existing pavement in Frederick St to accommodate the new heavy vehicle loadings and turning movements.
 - a. Please provide a pavement impact assessment of the Frederick St pavement to assess its current condition and determine what upgrade requirements may be required to ensure that pavement and surface integrity is maintained during the life of the development.

The due date for providing the requested information is 21 August 2023. Please advise North Burnett Regional Council of your response to this information request in accordance with section 13 of the Development Assessment Rules. To assist in your response, please find enclosed a standard response template you can use with your response if you wish.

As the North Burnett Regional Council's assessment of your application will be based on the information provided, it is recommended all the requested information is provided.

In accordance with section 14.2 of the Development Assessment Rules, if a response is not provided before the above due date (or a further agreed period), it will be taken as if you have decided not to respond to the information request and Council will continue with the assessment of your application without the information requested.
