Part 1 Preliminary

1 Short title

This local law may be cited as *Local Law (Amending) Subordinate Local Law No. 3 (Community and Environmental Management) 2024.*

2. Commencement

This local law commences on the date notice of the making of the local law is published in the gazette.

This local law amends Subordinate Local Law No. 3 (Community and Environmental Management) 2011.

4. Amendment of Section 7 (Prohibition on lighting or maintaining fires-Authorising local law, s 15(2))

Section 7 –

omit, insert –

⁶⁷ Prohibition on lighting or maintaining fires – Authorising local law, s15(2)

For section 15(2) of the authorising local law, lighting or maintaining a fire described in column 2 of schedule 3 is declared to be prohibited in the corresponding part of the local government's area mentioned in column 1 of schedule 3.'.

5. Amendment of Section 8 (Community safety hazards-Authorising local law, s17(c))

Section 8(a), (b), (c), (d), (e) and (f) -

omit, insert –

- '(a) any fencing incorporating barbed wire in an urban area;
- (b) electric fencing located in an urban area or on a lot that is smaller than 6000m2;
- (c) vegetation on premises which –

- (i) is dangerous or attracts vermin; or
- (ii) has caused, or is in the opinion of an authorised person, likely to cause
 - (A) personal injury or property damage; or
 - (B) a negative impact on the amenity of the surrounding area; and
- (d) an act or omission on premises which -
 - (i) is dangerous or attracts vermin; or
 - (ii) has caused, or is, in the opinion of an authorised person likely to cause
 - (A) personal injury or property damage; or
 - (B) a negative impact on the amenity of the surrounding area.'.

6. Amendment of Part 6 (Noise standards)

(1) Prescribed noise standards – authorising local law, s21(2) –

- '10. Prescribed noise standards authorising local law, s21(2)'.
- (2) Subsection (1) and (2) –
